

# Grey Street

## Improvement works

**South Bank Corporation is making important safety improvements to Grey Street (between Vulture Street and Russell Street) that will benefit pedestrians and motorists with upgrades to footpaths, centre road median crossings, lighting and landscaping.**

### WORKS WILL INVOLVE

- upgrading roadway and footpath lighting.
- installation of additional CCTV along the street.
- upgrading footpaths to remove trip hazards and damaged tree grates, as well as releveling of uneven surfaces.
- planting new and rehabilitating street trees and pergola vines.
- installing uprights within centre road median.
- planting new sub-tropical plants along the road median.

### ANTICIPATED PROJECT TIMING

To avoid major disruptions, the works will be delivered in stages. More information about the construction program for each stage will be available online as the works schedule is finalised.

- Mid-April 2023: Construction works to start (Stage 1)
- Late July 2023: Construction to be complete (Stage 4)
