FINAL SPRINT, GREY STREET SAFETY IMPROVEMENT WORKS NEARING COMPLETION

We are thrilled to announce that the final stage of the Grey Street Safety Improvement works is well underway.

This final phase focuses on crucial safety enhancements, including levelling uneven surfaces, eliminating trip hazards, and replacing damaged tree grates along specific sections of the footpath outside several Grey Street retail tenancies.

SCHEDULE OF FINAL WORKS

The safety improvements are being implemented sequentially in four stages at various locations along Grey Street, between Tribune and Glenelg streets. See the locations below:



Stage 1 works are due for completion in the coming days, and the team will continue to focus on stage 2.

FOOTPATH WORKS

- **Location:** Four locations along Grey Street, to progress sequentially.
- **Dates:** 11 October 2023 – 6 December 2023
- **Time:** 6am – 3pm, Monday – Friday daily (no weekend works)

Please note that during the demolition and concrete pouring stages, the section of Grey Street adjacent to each location will be temporarily closed for pedestrian safety. However, accessibility for all precinct stakeholders, including access to residences, will be maintained at all times.

The Corporation is fully committed to minimising disruptions as we deliver these crucial safety works for all footpath users.
