General precinct operations and maintenance works

- **South Bank Rail Platform 1 Upgrade:** Continue to stay up to date on night and weekend works by visiting the [Queensland Rail website](#).

- **South Bank Car Park Works:** Works to replace the northern ramp stormwater drain in the South Bank Car Park will commence on Monday, 28 February. These important and necessary works will run from 7am – 6pm daily until Monday, 6 March 2022. The northern ramp (Glenelg Street end of Little Stanley Street) will be closed for the duration of these works. All traffic will be redirected to use the southern entrance off Tribune Street.
