Brisbane Festival

South Bank Corporation is excited to be part of the 2021 Brisbane Festival. The month-long event will end with a bang on Saturday, 25 September 2021 with Riverfire being held at South Bank Parklands. The fireworks display will run from 6.45 pm to 7:05pm Please see below information about the event.

Security and closures

The following closures will be in place.

- Little Stanley Street will be closed from approximately 10am on Thursday 23 September until 5pm Sunday 26 September.
- Blocks will be placed at the edge of Ernest Street roundabout at 8am on Saturday 25 September.
- Fencing will be erected along the parkland side of Little Stanley Street from 6am Thursday 23 September.
- River Quay will also be fenced along Sidon Street and the Arbour.

There will be a heavy security presence for the event with bag searches at entry points from 9.00am on Saturday 25 September 2021. Please note entry points have been reduced this year.

Independent food safety audits
